Dear Friends, **April 30, 2022** 

We have a lot to report because God has been good to us for another month, but we are really excited about what might be done during the warm weather coming up. Thank you, again, for praying and supporting us financially. The Lord continues to especially bless Ukraine through you. We thank God that \$4,500 was donated this month to buy humanitarian supplies, bringing our total so far to \$22,500. We are also thankful for \$5,100 that was given toward buying a delivery van for Pastor Michael.

We decided last month that we would try to collect \$20,000 to replace Pastor Michael's van. The van is worn out from delivering 30 tons of supplies to Kharkov and other heavily bombed areas. We talked to Brother Michael, and he said that it would take close to \$30,000 to buy a vehicle in good condition and more suited to the present task, as well as use in the tent ministry after the war. The good news is that another ministry is ready to give \$15,000 when we can give the rest. So, it is simply great that we have already collected \$5,100 toward our goal. Just \$9,900 is lacking. **Please pray** that this need would be met soon.

Brother Andre Khudiakov and his wife are doing well. They are hoping to return to their home near Kyiv in June. Thank God that their home suffered only minimal damage when a missile hit the house next to them to the rear. Some windows were broken, and some shrapnel went through their roof. Their garage will also need repair. Andre has been collecting help for the refugee ministry of the Source of Life Church. He arranged \$2,000 to be given for firewood to heat the church. He has also collected \$1,500 for buying musical equipment for the sanctuary, and enough money to begin remodeling the church kitchen where six ladies work every day to cook food for the refugees.

**Praise the Lord,** we were able this month to give \$1,000 to the Temple of Peace in Kyiv. This was used for fuel to evacuate refugees from territory recently regained from the Russians.

Pastor Vasily in Piryatin continues to deliver supplies to isolated areas. His van h10as also started to have mechanical troubles. Thank God we were able to send \$800 to repair his van and \$500 for fuel. He is using this fuel to drive to the border where he can receive humanitarian aid that comes from Europe and bring it back to central Ukraine for distribution. Everyone is working together to do everything they can to achieve victory for their country.

We were able to give \$1,000 to the Born-Again Church who used it to finish filling six vans with supplies last week.

The Salvation Church is doing just a tremendous job. They are delivering approximately five tons of humanitarian relief each week, housing 60+ refugees each night, and feeding as many refugees as they can. There are now 50,000-100,000 refugees staying permanently in Poltava. They are mostly women and children who have been completely uprooted. Salvation Church invites then to special evangelistic meetings. It was necessary to hold two Easter worship services. This is a good problem for a church to have. **Please pray** for the great needs of this work.

Unfortunately, I was hospitalized for a week at the end of the month with cellulitis and a blood infection. I am presently at home taking continuous IV antibiotics for two more weeks. Please pray for me, Ukraine, and our **Brothers in India and Philippines.**
