Dear Friends,

Well, **Praise the Lord**, I am back safely from my trip to Philippines. Because of the timing, I was not here in USA at the end of October to write a prayerletter for that month. So, this letter will cover October and half of November, and my next letter will cover through the end of December. **Thank you** for praying for my brother, Bruce. He is still sober but was in the hospital again for another week while I was gone. He and my sister, Janet, both have very serious health problems. **Please continue** to pray for them and my grandchildren. Apparently, there was a lot of flu and RSV going around while I was gone.

**We thank God** that He is still preserving the nation of Ukraine, even giving some victories in the effort to push back the Russian aggression in some areas that were previously over-run. Our **focus** currently is to help maintain the **15 relief workers in Poltava's Salvation Church**. One friend of our ministry is continuing to give \$300/month for this purpose, and another has started sending \$1,000/month through our ministry. So, we are up to almost half of the **\$3,000/month** that is needed. **We are thankful** that \$500 was also given this month to help buy a van for the Born Again Church. This van will be used to deliver relief supplies to areas that Ukraine has re-taken from Russian control. **We are also thankful** that, even during this war-time situation, new churches are being finished and dedicated. The church in Rublivka, that we helped make early progress several years ago, is a wonderful example of perseverance by Ukrainian believers. **We thank God** that Brother Andre collected \$2,000 this month for the Source of Life Church and another \$2,000 to help refugees in the city of Kremenchuk.

**The first half of my trip to Philippines was successful.** The Lord blessed our dedication of the church sanctuary and parsonage. We also celebrated Pastor Appreciation Day that Sunday. Pastor Alfonso, Pastor de Pano, and I all received some wonderful gifts. I was able to preach at several police locations, a Senior Citizens Conference, the monthly children's feeding program, and at a two-day Sports Evangelism Camp. Of course, a highlight was to preach for my first time in the church that we helped to build. That was a great personal blessing for me. **We thank God that 45+ people made professions of faith** during these events. **The second half of my trip did not go as smoothly. I caught Covid-** probably while preaching in the jail- and spent my last week in **quarantine**. The symptoms were not pleasant but were more of a nuisance than anything else. **The Lord spared me any serious respiratory distress.** Another answer to prayer was that the long flight (15 hours) did not aggravate the poor circulation in my bad leg. **I am very thankful to all the people who prayed about this problem.** Our next project in Philippines is to partition off two rooms in the fellowship area. Brother Zaldy Velasquez will stay in one while he is going to Bible College and being mentored by Pastor Aris. Right now, Brother Zaldy sleeps on the floor of the church. The second room will be for storage. **Please pray for the \$500** that is needed for this project.

**Please continue to pray** for our work in India. **Pastor Joseph Nanneti's** health has improved, so he was busy this month. The church bathroom was finished with new tiles and fixtures. We continue to support 8 local pastors besides Brother Joseph. Our next project in India is to build a baptistry. The persecution of Christians in India has gotten so bad that people in Joseph's area are afraid to get baptized outside of the church. We must do whatever is necessary to continue making new converts who can follow the Lord in believer's baptism.
