There is a lot to report so I will not say as much about myself. I praise the Lord that my health continues to slowly recover. I have even started going to the gym to use the stationary bike and lift a few weights. My standing and walking are still limited, and I will find out in a couple of weeks whether I will need another back surgery. **Please continue to pray** about my situation. The stopping of most of my pain medicine has allowed me to start preaching again. I really enjoyed speaking twice at Meadow Bridge Missionary B.C. The folks there warmly welcomed my wife and me. So, the Lord continues to build my faith and bless our ministry. I am very grateful for His work in my life. He also uses and blesses my family. **Please pray** for my wife and daughter, Maryanne. They are in the Philippines for the next two weeks. Besides spending time with Nora's family, they will conduct their annual "Maria Project" (named after Nora's mother). This year they will buy and distribute food bags for around 500 families.

**Please pray extra** for Pastor Joseph Nanneti in India. He used the money we sent to have a good celebration of Christmas and the church's anniversary. He has not been able to send me any photos because the next day he **wrecked his motor scooter** and ended up in the hospital with severe injuries to his face and a blood clot on his brain. He is recovering at home now. It is difficult for him to speak, and he cannot use his right hand, **but he thanks God that he is alive**. This means he cannot use his cell phone to communicate with me. We are so grateful to Sewell Valley Baptist Church and friends of the ministry that gave \$600 to help with medical expenses.

Our friends in Ukraine are also in life-or-death circumstances. Instead of the usual report that is colorful and upbeat despite the war going on around them, here is the latest note from Alexander Yarmoshevich, Pastor of the Salvation church:

**"Greetings Brothers and Sisters in Christ- I hope you are doing well. Let me tell you a little about us. It is now -16°C. Today the alarm (air raid siren) went off 14 times, because of incoming drones and missiles. The enemy is destroying energy, heat, and people. There is no light in homes. Electricity is rationed at 4 hours of electricity per day. All of the electrical substations are inoperable. For houses with generators, the generators are running all day. Please pray for us. 🙏"**

They need much prayer. **We thank God** that we were able to send \$1900 this month for humanitarian aid.

**Thank you for praying for the ministry in Philippines.** We were able to send the \$275 needed to accomplish another month of feeding village children. Pastor Aris' congregation gave \$1,100 in their Christmas offering to use in constructing their church addition. They still need \$3,000. Pastor Arden De Pano will soon hold the first worship in the temporary church in San Fabian. He still needs several thousand dollars to prepare for building the new church. **Please pray** for these needs. The Joshua Tuck Memorial Scholarship Fund has committed to pay the college tuition of Pastor Aris' daughter, Annalois (\$400 x 3 trimesters x 4 years). **Please pray about everything.**
