Thank God that He continues to restore my health and strength as a result of your prayers on my behalf. **Thank you so much!** My appointment with the neurosurgeon this week resulted in the decision that surgery would not help the situation in my back at this time. Instead, on March 12, I will get injections in my spine below the site of my surgery. So, the good news is that I do not have to get my vertebrae fused together; but the sad news is, if the injections do not work, there is nothing else they can do about my pain and weakness. **I thank God** that I can walk further (even go on the treadmill) and do more light work than before. The past year has been drastically up and down, but I think I have leveled off now in a much better place. **Please continue to pray** about my situation. I was so happy to preach twice again this month at Meadow Bridge Missionary B. C. **Please pray** that the Lord would send them, and my home church (Sewell Valley B.C.), the right Pastor. **Thank you** for praying for my wife and daughter while they were in Philippines. **The Lord really blessed their “Maria Project”** as they distributed food to 625 families. **The Lord also blessed** my son, Isaiah, as he won an episode of “Wheel of Fortune.” His total, including cash and a trip to Ireland, was \$17,000. **Everybody in town is proud of him.** What I like, is that he is using his notoriety from appearances on “Wheel of Fortune” and “Alone” to get opportunities to preach.

Thank you for praying for Pastor Joseph Nanneti in India after his vehicle accident. He is walking and speaking now but it is very painful, and he has limited use of his right hand. **Thank God,** we have been able to send \$200/month for medicine and physiotherapy from the money that was given last month for that purpose. Other pastors have been helping to continue worship services in his church. Soon, when he is a little stronger, he wants to have a special **“Praise God”** meeting to show thanksgiving for the Lord preserving his life.

Well, this week marked the **end of four years of war in Ukraine.** You and I cannot begin to imagine how much suffering has happened in that time. **Please keep praying for God to end this tragedy.** Imagine, in the middle of winter, in a naturally cold land, there is electricity (heat and water) for only four hours on a good day. **Please pray** for more mercy on them. **I am so thankful** that we were able to send \$2,200 this month for humanitarian aid.

Thank you for praying for the ministry in Philippines. We were able to send the \$275 needed to accomplish another month of feeding village children. Progress is being made on the church addition. Pastor Aris still needs \$2,000 for ceilings, drywall, floor tiles, doors, and windows. Pastor Arden De Pano held his first worship service in the temporary meeting place in San Fabian. On February 8, after clearing the brush, a dedication service was held on the new church lot. **They have an interesting tradition of burying a Bible under the place where the pulpit will be.** The next step is to fill in the lot to raise it above flood level. 12 dump truck loads are needed. Each one cost \$100. **Please pray** for the Lord to provide the fill dirt and another \$1,500 for electricity, a deep well, and a restroom. Pastor Aris, Pastor Arden, and their wives will apply for visas to visit the USA around May to seek financial support for building their churches. Aris’ wife, Connie, especially wants to meet their present supporters.
