
Dear Friends,

Well, **thank you, Lord**- this first paragraph where I bring everyone up to date about my health keeps getting shorter. I received steroid injections in my lower back last week and they helped a lot. Now I can work at my desk without time restriction. I can stand up to do light physical work with much less pain and for longer periods of time. I am finally getting some things done that had gotten put off for the last year and a half. I am so happy to report progress on remodeling our ministry office and my home. It took me less than one week to prepare all the reports that are needed for our upcoming annual meeting of our Board of Directors. Last year it took almost one month. **Please pray** that the effects of these injections will not wear off too soon. I can only repeat them every three months. I am starting to get back into preaching. **Lord willing**, I will preach this Easter's Sunrise Service at Big Sewell Baptist Church. My mind is much clearer now since I have gone a couple weeks without taking any pain pill. **I really believe that the Lord is allowing my body to recover and be strengthened because of all the people who have been praying for me. Thank you so much! Please continue to request God's mercy on me.**

Thank you for praying for Pastor Joseph Nanneti in India after his vehicle accident. He is still restricted in walking, speaking, and using his right hand. Those problems are lingering because he still has blood clots in his brain. He requires medicine that has been costing \$200/month. We have used the \$600 that was already given for this purpose. **Please pray** that the Lord will provide for this need for another three months. The pastors of small local churches that he mentors have been helping him to maintain his church. Together, they held two days of special services to praise and thank God for sparing his life. These meetings were held on the roof of the church because of opposition from neighbors. About 80 people attended, including some unbelievers. **Brother Joseph and his family still need much prayer.**

My heart is so broken over the war in Ukraine. It is already difficult for me because of the danger that my friends are in almost constantly now. Last night, Russia sent 400 drones to attack several areas of Ukraine. This included Poltava where my ministry in Ukraine is based. Several people were killed. Of course, the greatest tragedy is the loss of life, but it is very sad for me to see photos of familiar places that have been bombed. **Please pray** for an increase of God's mercy on the people and the country of Ukraine. **I am so thankful** that we were able to send \$1,875 this month for humanitarian aid besides regular support for several preachers. **Please pray.**

Thank you for praying for the ministry in Philippines. It continues to grow in a special way because of God's blessing and the congregation's hard work. They will celebrate the church's 7th anniversary on March 29. As usual, Brother Aris is trying to get as much improvement done before then as he can. **Thank God**, \$300 was given to pay for paving the driveway in front of the church and along the addition where much progress has been made. **Please pray** that the Lord would provide what is needed to finish construction of the addition before Brother Aris and his wife travel to USA later this year. They each need \$200 to apply for a visa. **Praise God**, we were able to send the usual \$275 for this month's children's feeding program. God is also blessing Pastor De Pano and the daughter church in San Fabian, but they also need much prayer and help with many needs. **Pray for them.**
